Sad secret of Babe in the Wood

TRAGIC Babe In The Wood Nicola Fellows was a sex abuse victim even before her violent death. It was revealed last night. Teenager Marion Stevenson has told how she caught a man ogling the sad nine-year-old girl in a kinky child porn video.

The pensive 11-year-old spoke out after her former husband, Bishop, was sensationalised as murdering Nicole and her friend Karen Madaway, also nine.

Marion, who now works as a childminder, confessed: "I visited a friend on the Housescumb estate in Brighton.

"The husband was watching TV, and I glanced at the screen. "I could see Nicky lying on her back, her face to the camera. It

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was definitely her. "There was a man lying on top of her with a blanket pulled up to his waist. It was a lodger in the house I was visiting."

"The top of the lodger's body was naked, and from what I could see of Nicky, so was she.

And the hunky star booked into a measure £150-a-night suite at the Plaza Athena Hotel—just round the corner from Princess Anne.

The Princess was just yards away in a double-bedroomed suite at the Grand Hotel.

And within minutes of

Anne leaving Paris, Andrews, 39, amazingly checked out of his posh hotel and headed back to the Roissy base.

The dashing star raged: "People are always making something out of something. (His exact words.)

"People can make of this what they want to." But angry Andrews refused to deny he had been calling and meeting

EXCLUSIVE: Cleared murder JAILBIRD

BABES In The Wood murder suspect Russell Bishop gingerly poked at his prison meal and knew that one mouthful would send him on an agonising death.

For razor-sharp shards of broken glass

had been mixed with his mashed potatoes.

Russell Bishop suffered a tormented year of hell after he was wrongly accused of the sex murders of nine-year-olds Nicola Fellows and Karen Hadaway in a Brighton wood.

And he revealed last night "I was stripped of my dignity. The inhumane atmosphere was unbelievable."

"I remember going for meals and seeing the broken glass glinting in the light in the mash we were supposed to eat."

"I never had a proper meal all the time I was inside, only a few chips at the most, because I was afraid of being poisoned or eating glass."

"I had to live on just the fruit, biscuits and crisp my family brought for me."

When Russell, 21, was arrested he little realised the nightmare that was in store for him. During his time in jail he was

LOOKED up with criminal mental cases.

HEATED black and blue by other prisoners, and

TERMINATED by prison staff who threatened him with horrifying injuries.

Kicked

Russell, who lives in Stevens Road, Brighton, still shudders as he recalls.

As soon as I'd appeared in court a big police convoy took me to Brighton Jail and I was rushed into the hospital. I was where the nutty prisoners go, to put it bluntly.

After a week or two, I was thrashed around the face with a bit of wood by another prisoner. He never said anything. Just hit me because of the crimes I was accused of.

The pain soon went away but there were constant threats against me. I was called a "necro"—jail slang for a child-sex beast. Other prisoners kicked, threw doors to try and frighten me and could hear some of them screaming.

Cleaners said they'd throw hot water over me but they never had the bottle to do anything because they were afraid of losing their cushy jobs.

I got a beating in April when I answered back to a warden. He just smacked me in the mouth. I had a fat lip but wasn't really hurt. Everything stripped me of my dignity—I was even made to sleep on a double time.

But Russell's lowest ebb came last Christmas "not because everybody outside was enjoying themselves but because my girlfriend Jenny was having our second baby. Hayley."

Russell tried to cope with the anguish by blocking reality from his mind.

"I just didn't want to know that she was having our child," he said. "I tried to shut it out."

But there was always a reminder that brought him back to reality with a jolt.

He said: "I started listening to the radio, but I could hear the time-check every hour and

POLICE USED 16-YEAR-OLD AS SEX BAIT

SEXY Marion Stevenson was just 16 when police ordered her to sleep with Russell Bishop. They wanted a bedroom confession to the Babes In The Wood murders.

Though Bishop had a steady girlfriend in Jenny Johnson, Marion was his secret lover.

Last night she revealed: "A police sergeant told me, 'Make love to him and ask him if he killed those little girls.'"

What the officer didn't tell her was that their love bedroom was BUGGED.

Shocked Marion went along with the idea because she was certain Russell was innocent.

But when the pair were alone, Russell discovered a bug. Marion managed to convince him there couldn't be others and that police wouldn't be listening anyway.

She continued: "We eventually fell into bed and made love passionately for about 15 hours. He was a randy sod."

"I was really loving it on that because I now realised we were being bugged. I was shouting

out, moaning and groaning because in the back of my mind I knew the police were listening."

"I really put on a show for them."

"Afterwards we lay on the bed together and I pushed up courage to say 'Fuck, did you like it?'. He knew exactly what I meant."

"He said, 'No I didn't, Maz.' That's his nickname for me. 'Honestly, I couldn't do anything like that.'"

"Then he put his arms around me, cried like a baby and said 'The bastard who did it should be strung up.'"

kept wondering how many hours it would be before I got out.

"But despite the hatred in Britain, all the suicides—there were at least three that year at that jail—and the beatings I used to hear at night, I knew I was different.

"Because I hadn't done anything."

He kept protesting his innocence to the other prisoners and eventually, he says, they started getting the message and the attacks gradually petered out.

Agony

But nothing he had suffered prepared him for the biggest torment of all.

"That was climbing the steps up to the dock of Leves Crown Court for my murder trial," he said. "That was sheer agony.

"I can't thank enough the people who got me through my ordeal—especially my solicitor Ralph Isaacs.

"He was convinced of my innocence and he fought tooth and nail from the very start to help me prove it. He was fantastic."

But nobody sacrificed more for Russell's freedom than his mother Sylvia, 46.

When she discovered she had cancer of the throat she made the agonising decision to go to Bristol Jail and tell Russell.

"She felt the shock would jolt him out of his despondency and make him fight for the chance to be free before she died."

Thankfully, the cancer was benign and plucky Sylvia will have an operation on Wednesday.

To cap the family celebrations, Russell last night cuddled up to girlfriend Jenny Johnson, 22, and announced their plans to wed.

But their obvious happiness is still tinged with dread.

With his voice scarcely a whisper he confessed: "I can't stop thinking about those poor little girls and the fact that somebody, somewhere, is walking the streets knowing they killed them."

"As long as the killer is free there will be people who still believe I did it."

Tomorrow Russell and Jenny will take a small step back to normality for their children Victor, three, and one-year-old Hayley.

They whole family is off to buy a Christmas tree.

But Marion also revealed that Nicola was no little innocent. She added: "Nicky knew all about sex."

"She'd go up to men strangers, pull her dress up, and make rude suggestions."

"It was so disgusting it made me feel sick."

Back home Nicola's father Barry Fellows was the prime agitator in a local campaign AGAINST the banning of video nasties.

But he could not take it when the atmosphere got a bit nasty in Russell Bishop's murder trial.

He stormed out of the court when defence QC Ivan Lawrence named him as a man with a history of violence and who had "a very weak will" for the time of the killings.

Fellows had even insisted on seeing his tee before searching for the missing girls.

Mr Lawrence pointed out in court that because of the timing of the murders Fellows was in the clear.

But on the day of Nicola's funeral, Fellows' neighbours seemed to disagree.

Then they doubted on his walk.

"Child molester! Child killer! Fellows out!"
